





Re: Official Information Act request - Energy Transition Accelerator panellist funding

Thank you for your request on 07 October 2022. You requested the following information under the Official Information Act 1982:

The value of EECA/Government funding that each of the ten Energy Transition Accelerator panellists have received from September 2020 to August 2022.

The following information falls within the scope of your request:

EECA does not provide funding directly to Energy Transition Accelerator (ETA) panellists. EECA co-funding is provided to the client business upon completion of agreed milestones and ETA client businesses pay the ETA panellist upon completion of the agreed services.

The values provided below are the amount of co-funding for ETA Opportunity Assessments EECA has paid directly to client businesses from September 2020 to August 2022, aggregated by the panellist who completed the work.
